

Introduction

In 2023 we saw further evidence of the resilience of the Infrastructure and Energy Transition sector, although not without some headwinds to contend with. The most worn-out phrase of the year was surely the tiresome 'denominator effect', but the signs in H2 were that infra fundraising is coming back and that we will stop hearing about it in 2024. Despite fundraising woes, hiring in the sector was strong throughout the year, especially for those businesses in the happy position of having dry powder to invest. The data to follow in this edition of One Search's People Moves Report for North America showcases the last half-year's career moves across investment, investor relations & fundraising, legal, and ESG & sustainability professionals in the Infrastructure and Energy Transition private markets. We are delighted to congratulate everyone who has made a career move in H2 of 2023 and wish them the best in their new roles.

One clear indication of the strength of Infrastructure has been the continued interest that large asset managers have had in acquiring infrastructure GPs. Notably in the past six months, ECP and DIF Capital Partners were acquired by Bridgepoint Group and CVC Capital Partners, respectively. As discussed in previous editions of this report, an inorganic growth strategy is a very effective means for asset managers to enter the Infrastructure markets. Large benefits of this include the acquisition of an existing and healthy portfolio, a ready-made team to continue building on, and the avoidance of the fundraising risk that is associated with a first-time fund in a sector where you have no track record. We anticipate seeing more of this in 2024.

Unsurprisingly, some of the largest fundraising milestones achieved this year have come from private credit funds. This included the hard cap close of Blackstone Green Private Credit Fund III at \$7.1bn. The opportunity for private credit has continued to expand and deal flow has been high, particularly across Energy Transition and Digital Infrastructure. An example of this is the Power Sustainable Infrastructure Credit team, who announced their inaugural investment in Vantage Data Centers shortly after closing \$600m. The last couple of years showed tremendous growth of Digital Infrastructure in private equity, with various buildouts and numerous hires. We're now seeing private credit and project finance teams undertaking similar growth in the sector as we head into 2024. As our late partner Danny Muir would say, "the debt always chases the equity."

During what has arguably been the most challenging fundraising market since the global financial crisis, investor relations professionals have been feeling the squeeze. There have been murmurings of boutique placement agents raising zero tickets for the year and winding down. We've also heard about private funds groups abandoning underperforming strategies to concentrate their efforts and resources on products that are experiencing greater success in these market conditions. On the other hand, in-house hiring by GPs has remained very active and 2023 was a transformative year for the continued evolution of the product specialist role. Whether looking at large asset managers with historically generalist distribution teams or an Infrastructure fund manager diversifying with a new strategy, hybrid fundraisers with product knowledge and a rolodex were in demand. We don't expect this to slow down anytime soon.

Speaking to LPs, there is no doubt whatsoever that the sentiment for the asset class remains strong, with 88% of institutional investors looking to either maintain or increase their allocation to Infrastructure, according to Infrastructure Investor's recent Investor Report. Nonetheless, Infrastructure investors are always looking toward their next moves and for many, that may include the opening of a new investor base in private wealth or retail.

There have been headlines like Brookfield's closing of Infrastructure's largest closed-end fund at \$28bn and KKR seeking to raise \$7bn for its first global climate fund. These teams, their subsequent new funds and their portfolio companies will inevitably need to continue hiring the best available talent – and we at One Search look forward to partnering with some of them in this regard! Until then, please enjoy the following report which compiles public moves made within the Americas Infrastructure, Energy, & Digital space over H2 of 2023. 

Decarbonization's Blind Spot

Following on from our H1 report earlier this year, we have seen a continuing acceleration in search mandates aligned to the thematic of decarbonization rather than targeted industry verticals. With COP28 recently bringing together leading minds and investors across the global energy sector to deliberate on the ongoing push to foster climate action and drive the net-zero agenda, we are seeing increased movement in the North American market at all seniority levels towards investment platforms deploying capital via decarbonization strategies. This is true both for early-stage venture platforms as well as later stage private equity. That being said, when we look at market activity there continues to be a gap in funding for late-stage venture companies entering the capital-intensive growth stage required for these asset-heavy investments to scale and reach commercialization.

In 2022 more than \$1 trillion was deployed globally into low-carbon technologies and for the first time, capital deployment into low-carbon alternatives was on-par with investment into traditional oil and gas. Large strategies launched in previous years, such as Brookfield's 2022 \$15 billion Global Transition Fund, have continued to commit significant capital to scale infrastructure projects such as wind, solar, battery and carbon capture/ storage technologies. These large ticket sizes require relatively proven and

de-risked technologies to satisfy the risk-adjusted returns profiles. At the earlier stage the higher volume of venture firms deploying seed and series A rounds typically focus on unproven, higher-risk technologies with the ability to significantly scale. Growth investors, such as General Atlantic and S2G Ventures, are now bridging that gap with late venture and growth equity style investments to allow these technologies to reach commercialization. However, these types of investors remain limited and many companies are still failing to cross the 'second valley of death' to secure the capital required to push past venture stages and reach a bankable risk profile to access traditional project finance capital to scale.

New strategies launching in this 'missing middle' are attracting a range of profiles. KKR, for example, has recently brought in Charlie Gailliot, a long-time private markets investor and former Partner from GSAM's merchant banking division, alongside Emmanuel Lagarrigue, an energy industry veteran, to colead their global climate strategy. Our clients are asking us to provide a wide range of profiles as they consider how to launch their own decarbonization strategies and the type of track records that are best suited to do this. We are likely to see moves from both ends of the investment spectrum to fill this gap as well as newcomers from adjacent industries and corporate backgrounds.

CEOs Fueling Private Markets: The Growing Need for Operational Fluency at the Fund Level

In my previous commentary in the H1 of 2023 People Moves Report, I discussed the ongoing trend of professionals transitioning from banks and funds to take up leadership and strategic roles within portfolio companies. While this movement continues to gain momentum, at One Search, we have also been supporting our clients in the placements of Operating Partners and value creation specialists at the fund level. This has been aided by an observation of a growing interest among current and former CEOs, General Managers, and P&L leaders to pivot into private markets.

In the realm of infrastructure investing, the percentage of our clients investing in businesses rather than directly into assets has been growing for over a decade. This shift has elevated the importance of robust operational fluency at the fund level to effectively manage these businesses and provide them with strategic direction. While not a novel concept, we anticipate this trend to persist and gather even more traction in the year ahead.

Private markets investors, as a standard practice, seek to recruit Operating Partners and Asset Managers with substantial P&L experience, whether

from PE-backed businesses or large corporations. This talent contributes immense value at the fund level, leveraging their extensive experience in areas such as strategic guidance, M&A and integration support, exit planning and execution, and risk management. Additionally, transitioning from a C-suite position to an investment manager offers several advantages. This includes remuneration packages and carried interest incentives, but the strategic opportunities for these executives are often the largest motivating factor. Unlike C-suite positions in industry that may only oversee a singular business unit, Operating Partners and Asset Managers can spearhead the strategy and growth for 2-5 businesses simultaneously.

As the need for stronger operational fluency at the fund level continues to grow, we believe processes will become more efficient, exit values to become larger, and businesses will scale quicker. As a collaborative effort between our investment and portfolio leadership search practices, we're quite energized about the opportunity to continue and increasingly identify top-tier, vetted talent for our private markets funds clients.



The Impact of Rising Interest Rates on Hiring

One common talking point throughout 2023 has been the effects of rising interest rates and the rising cost of capital. One impact of these macroeconomic trends, combined with the effects of the Inflation Reduction Act, is an increased demand for private credit and debt investments. As noted by BlackRock's Head of High Yield Credit, Daniel Fuchs, these conditions have made infrastructure debt highly attractive, especially considering the decreased willingness of banks to underwrite for sponsors. Additionally, the fact that debt has adjusted prices quicker than equity and increased cost of capital creating similar levels of return between debt and equity has further driven demand for private credit solutions. Another factor that is driving demand for infrastructure debt is the fact that the increased cost of capital has created similar levels of return between debt and equity.

Another factor driving this trend is that sponsors are continuing to look for partners who can provide flexibility in lending. There has been an increasing desire from sponsors to find more non-dilutive forms of capital that tend to fall somewhere between senior debt and equity. As noted by BlackRock's Head of High Yield Credit, Daniel Fuchs, in Infrastructure Investor's Round Table "Changing of the Guard" these conditions have made infrastructure debt highly attractive, especially considering the decreased willingness of

banks to underwrite for sponsors. In addition to high-yield credit, sponsors also look for flexibility on repayment timing and understanding that cash flow variability isn't always a cause for concern that credit and debt platforms can provide.

With the increased demand for private credit and debt, one would think that would correlate to increased hiring from private credit and debt funds. However, there was minimal change in the percentage of moves to private credit and debt funds. In H2 2023 34% of the moves were made to private credit and debt funds, compared to 33% in H2 2021 when interest rates were low. Interestingly, about half of the hires in H2 2023 were junior hires compared to a much more even split between junior, mid, and senior hires in H2 2021.

One potential reason we do not see an increase in hiring at the fund level in 2023 is because 2023 has been a difficult fundraising year, particularly in H1. It will be interesting to see if there is an increase in hiring as fundraising increases. Finally, the increased demand for private credit and debt could have led to a higher percentage of junior hires as funds needed to focus more on execution than origination.

ESG - Growing in Importance

2023 marks a pivotal turning point in sustainability and ESG, with the landscape becoming more regulated across all geographies. COP 28 has also confirmed that nature solutions will be a key focus moving forward. To this end, One Search has been at the forefront of engaging with funds that are passionate about driving systemic and transformational change as evidenced by our ESG roundtables in which LPs and GPs discussed the challenges and opportunities from across the Infrastructure spectrum.

It is clear from the market that investors are increasingly recognizing the long-term impact of climate change on their investments. Crucial ESG factors such as climate risk, talent management, and board composition can significantly affect a company's financial performance and intrinsic value, prompting asset owners and institutional money managers to prioritize ESG considerations. The public markets are also experiencing heightened governance standards enforced by ESG rating agencies and proxy advisers. Our view of some prominent market trends over for the past year are included below:

Fundraising

In 2023, despite a decline in overall fundraising, the number of ESG funds increased. A few examples of such ESG funds include:

- 1. Vision Ridge Partners raised \$700 million to further their current sustainability investment platform, targeting core-plus energy transition investments
- 2. Sandbrook Capital raised \$1.5 billion to focus on climate infrastructure in the U.S.A
- 3. NGP Energy Capital Management also closed at \$700 million for their energy transition fund
- 4. Ares Climate Infrastructure II raised approximately \$500 million with a target of \$3 billion

Litigation

Given the evolution of the sustainability landscape, there has been an increase in large-scale, complex litigation. For instance, in the USA, major

financial institutions settled with the SEC over ESG-related disputes, indicating a trend toward heightened regulatory scrutiny. As such, we have also seen an increased demand for ESG Legal roles both in the USA and European markets.

Chief Sustainability Officers

In the past year, there has been a steady rise in the hiring of Chief Sustainability Officers (CSOs) within funds and corporations in North America. Examples of appointed CSOs in 2023 include Meaghan Muldoon who joined BNY Mellon as CSO. Erica Brinker was hired by Chaberton Energy as Chief Commercial & Sustainability Officer. Gwennael Guillen was appointed by Allied Gold Corporation as CSO. Ji Rim joined Civitas Resources as CSO as well. These new CSOs are generally responsible for the overall sustainability strategy, governance, and execution, with oversight over both corporate and/or investment sustainability teams.

Nature, Data & DEI

Other roles that have seen a rise are heads of nature-based solutions and data specialists. We have also seen an increased focus on diversity and inclusion at both the fund and portfolio levels (for instance more than half of the hires included in our reports for both the USA and EMEA have been female).

Outlook

The OECD estimates an annual investment requirement of \$6.9 trillion until 2050 for low-carbon infrastructure development. Fueled by strong support for ESG investing, assets in this sector may grow to potentially \$20–\$30 trillion by 2030. Therefore, we expect that building robust ESG teams within portfolio companies and funds will continue in 2024.




